CLOTHING:

- o Short Sleeve Shirts
- o Pants for around Camp x 1
- o Hunting/Hiking pants x 2
- o Non Cotton Hiking Socks
- o Underwear
- o Long underwear top
- o Long underwear bottom
- o Mid-weight Long Sleeve Shirt/Sweater
- o Insulated Jacket (*Synthetic Down is ideal*)
- o Rain Coat (*used dually as wind and snow protection in cold weather conditions*)
- o Rain Pants
- o Warm PJs
- o Gloves - Light and Warm
- o Cap or Brimmed Hat
- o Stocking Hat

FOOTWEAR:

- o High Quality Hiking Boots (*Kenetrek, Meindl, Scarpa*)
- o Boot Gaiters (*Outdoor Research*)
- o Camp shoes or boots

GEAR & ACCESSORIES:

- o (2) 1 Liter Water Bottles (*Nalgene*)
- o Binoculars with Chest Harness
- o Camera
- o Fly Fishing Gear (*if desired*)
- o Hunting Pack
- o Knife
- o Headlamp
- o Batteries
- o Bath towel, wash cloth, soap
- o Toiletries and Medications
- o Scope covers
- o Hunting Licenses
- o Sleeping Bag (*rated to 0 Degrees*)
- o Pillow
- o Safety glasses and/or helmet to be worn while riding (*optional*)
- o Your Firearm
- o Ammunition (*20 rounds*)
- o Fluorescent Orange (*1 garment such as hat or vest*)
- o Rifle case for travel – we provide scabbards for horses.
- o Book/Magazine/Reading Material

PRACTICE AT HOME

- o Sight your rifles in at 200 yards;
- o Typically, our shots range from 100 to 300 yards;
- o Practice shooting while wearing the gear you plan to hunt with.

PACKING TIPS

Non-cotton clothing is essential to your safety when you encounter adverse weather conditions in the field. Beyond safety, proper clothing will keep you comfortable and allow you to function optimally in the field, even during adverse weather conditions, increasing your odds of success on your hunt and enhancing the enjoyment of your wilderness experience.

Do not overload your hunting pack with unnecessary gear. You need to be able to move quickly in the field. Do not burden yourself with gear you don't absolutely need. You need to be focused on hunting, not carrying a heavy pack. Your guide will be carrying an extensive load of gear in their pack including first aid, game bags, field dressing tools, emergency supplies, and water purification.

All personal gear, excluding hunting pack and weapon, should be packed in two medium duffel bags (25 lb maximum each).
